SUMMARY OF RESPONSIBILITIES

The Graphics and Production Coordinator (Adventure Avenue/Baby Bay) provides assistance with editing acquired curriculum for the Adventure Avenue (AA) and Baby Bay (BB) environments. Coordinates the technical aspects of the AA weekly program including instructing the tech volunteers with weekend duties. Assists with various tasks in the execution of the weekly stage presentation and weekly video production of KidzWorld YouTube videos.

The incumbent must perform all job duties as outlined in this job description to support ongoing mission of the church while committed in accordance with the *Baptist Faith and Message (2000 edition)*.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES

- Edits slides, videos, handouts, and other media elements to implement into the weekend services by using Adobe Suite software—Photoshop, Premiere Pro, Illustrator, etc. Creates graphics as needed. Assists with filming weekly content videos for KidzWorld YouTube channel, including weekend online church and mid-week videos. Loads all technical aspects in the theater, as well as in individual classrooms. (app. 60%)
- Coordinates the technical aspects of the weekend program. Gives technical
 instructions and direction to tech volunteers and staff for the weekend production in
 the theater. Performs tech roles as needed during the weekend services including
 running ProPresenter, lights, and setting up to record the theater weekend program.
 (app. 20%)
- Assists with the planning and weekly execution of theater skits, stories, and games in both theater and traveling puppet teams. Greets children and makes sure they are obeying all safety rules during check-in. (app. 10%)
- Practices and assists for special events including special holiday services, FX, Say Yes, Parent Day In The Bay, Big Idea Experience, and camp (app. 5%)
- Assists in planning and coordinating the production elements for Parent Day In The Bay, FX, Christmas Eve services, and other special events. (app. 5%)

These duties are subject to change as church needs and strategies evolve. Employee may be required to perform other duties.

EDUCATION/TRAINING

- A minimum of a high school diploma is required.
- College courses in video and graphics preferred.
- Certified aerial and scissor lift operator preferred.

EXPERIENCE

- A minimum of 2-3 years of experience in a children's ministry.
- A minimum of 1 year of experience in video editing and grapic design.

- Knowledge of Adobe Suites software and ProPresenter.
- Knowledge of computers and the ability to learn new software programs.
- Basic knowledge of video creation and editing techniques.
- Basic camera equipment experience.
- Communication and coordination skills.
- Positive temperament, dependability, and professionalism.
